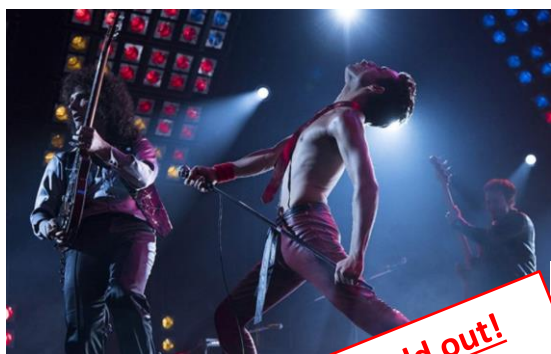
St Stephen's Ashill Church Services

Easter Weekend Beer Festival

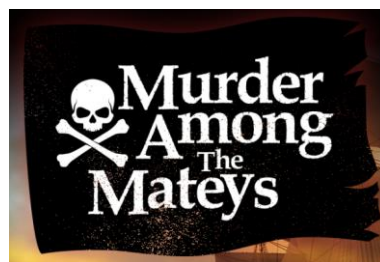
at The Ashill Inn
